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## Lord Mayor's Foreword

It is fitting that Cork City Council should adopt a strategic plan for the best used cultural facility in the city in this historic year, when Cork holds the title of European Capital of Culture.

I am delighted that the Library Service first sought the views of the public in laying the groundwork for this plan, and the 200 + submissions received shows the importance which the people of Cork attach to their Library. The Library in the 21<sup>st</sup> century must be more than just a facility to be used or not as the need arises; it must always be "a publicly funded intervention in the lives of individuals and communities", giving access to learning and culture in a way that would not otherwise be possible. In a very real sense the library must break through its walls and reach out to every community in the city if it is truly to be a resource for all.

Having said that, however, 21<sup>st</sup> century libraries need 21<sup>st</sup> century buildings. One of the first fruits of this plan will be the opening of the newly constructed Tory Top Library. This is currently nearing completion on the site of the building which served the southside for some thirty years. The Council intend to follow this with the long-awaited library for Bishopstown and the western suburbs, and we hope that the contractors will be on site early in 2005.

I wish the Library Service, its users and its staff every success in the implementation of this plan.

Oireann sé go mór gur i mbliana a dhein Comhairle Cathrach Chorcaí plean straitéiseach a chur i bhfeidhm don áis chultúrtha is mó úsáid i gcathair Chorcaí agus an chathair mar Phríomhchathair Chultúrtha na hEorpa.

Tá áthas orm gur chuaigh an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne i dteagmháil ar dtús leis an bpobal agus iad ag cóiriú an plean seo. 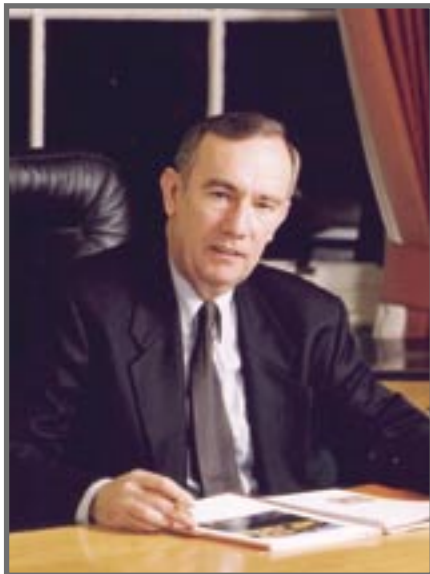
## City Manager's Foreword

This plan fulfils the statutory obligation on Cork City Council to prepare a library development programme but it is much more than that: it pro-actively commits the Council to developing its libraries to be a national and indeed international leader in public library services.

The major cross-cutting themes in this plan echo those of other strategies and policies of the Council and other agencies: the need for an enhanced public realm which the library as a community space can fulfil, cultural diversity in our changing city enriching us all, and the enthusiastic embrace of the possibilities offered by information and communications technologies.

Recent years have seen a major shift in how libraries are regarded and how the service perceives itself. Libraries are now concerned with the learning society, with social inclusion, and with a more participative cultural life. For children they offer the first chance and the best chance to open the doors to the world of knowledge. Like other public services there is also a greater emphasis on improving quality and accountability.

Coupled with this major shift in the nature of libraries, this plan marks a very significant change in how the service will be delivered. For many decades the service was delivered only through the City Library in Grand Parade; from the early 1970s a number of branch libraries were opened. From 2005 the service will be delivered through three strands: through the Central Library, still by far the most important service point, through the network of local libraries, and through a virtual electronic library offering a full digital service online.

Ar ndóigh deineann an plean seo i bhfad níos mó ná sin - cuireann sé ceangail atá gníomhach ar an gComhairle a cuid leabharlanna a bheith chun cinn i soláthar seirbhísí leabharlainne poiblí go náisiúnta ach go hidirnáisiúnta.

Léiríonn cuid de na téamaí sa phlean seo téamaí atá le braith i bpolasaithe eile na Comhairle maraon le polasaithe a bhaineann le gníomhaireachtaí eile: ar na téamaí sin tá an gá atá leis an raon poiblí a fheabhsú, ag tosú leis an ról lárnach atá ag an leabharlann mar spás poiblí a fhorbairt, tá an éagsúlacht chultúrtha ag méadú i saol na cathrach agus saibhrítear ár saoil dá réir agus táthar ag forbairt go

fionnmhar an úsáid a deintear as féidearthachtaí teicneolaíochta an eolais agus na cumarsáide.

Tá athrú mór tagtha le blianta beaga anuas ar an slí go bhféachann daoine ar leabharlanna maraon le hathrú ar conas a fhéachann an tseirbhís uirthi féin. Tuigeann leabharlanna anois go bhfuil siad ag plé le pobal foghlama, ag plé le pobal cuimsitheach agus ag plé anois le pobal a ghlacann páirt níos mó sa saol cultúrtha. Cuireann siad an deis is túisce agus an deis is fearr ar fáil do pháistí na doirse a leathadh ar dhomhan na feasachta. Cosúil le seirbhísí poiblí eile tá béim mhór anois ar chaighdeán agus ar fhreagracht a fheabhsú.

Maraon leis an mórathrú seo i nádúr leabharlanna, céim ar leith atá sa phlean seo a léiríonn conas atá sé i gceist an tseirbhís a sholáthar amach anseo. Ar feadh na scórtha bliain bhí an tseirbhís á chur ar fáil trí Leabharlann na Cathrach ar Shráid an Chapail Bhuí amháin agus ansin ó thús na 1970' aí d'oscailíodh roinnt leabharlanna áitiúla. ## 1. Background and Context

### 1.1 Introduction

Cork City Council is the democratically elected forum for the development of the city, and, as the leading player in the social, infrastructural, economic and cultural development of the city and its people, provides a diverse range of services. The Council, and its predecessor Cork Corporation, has provided a library service to the people of the city since 1892.

Cork City Council is obliged by the Local Government Act 2001 to prepare both 5-year corporate plans and library development programmes. This strategic plan for the library service complements the corporate plan, as it covers the same time period and is, in effect, a more detailed statement of what is contained in the library section of the corporate plan. This plan also meets the requirements under section 78 of the Act, which states that "a library authority shall from time to time . . . prepare and adopt a programme for the operation and development of its library service".

In preparing this plan the Council invited the public, users and non-users alike, to submit their comments about the service and their suggestions about how it should be improved. Some 200 submissions were received in the autumn of 2004. These submissions and the suggestions and proposals made by staff, all of whom took part in the consultation and preparation process, form the basis of the plan.

This strategic plan comprises:

- a discussion of the current position of the library service and its social and economic context in the city and region;
- a critical examination of the library service's strengths and weaknesses, and the external opportunities and threats it faces;
- a statement of the purpose of the library service

## 1. Cúlra agus Comhthéacs

### 1.1 Réamhrá

Is í Comhairle Cathrach Chorcaí an fóram tofa daonlathach atá ann chun an chathair a fhorbairt agus, mar cheannródaí i bhforbairt shóisialta, bhonneagair, eacnamaíoch agus chultúrtha na cathrach agus i bhforbairt mhuintir na cathrach, cuireann sí réimse éagsúil seirbhísí ar fáil. Tá an Chomhairle agus Bardas Chorcaí, mar a bhíodh uirthi, ag cur seirbhís leabharlainne ar fáil ón mbliain 1892 i leith. Faoi Acht an Rialtais Áitiúil 2001, tá dualgas ar Chomhairle Cathrach Chorcaí pleananna corparáideacha agus cláracha forbartha leabharlainne chúig bliana a ullmhú. Tagann an plean straitéiseach seo don tseirbhís leabharlanna leis an bplean corparáideach mar gheall go gclúdaíonn sé an tréimhse chéanna agus is éard atá ann go bunúsach ná ráiteas níos doimhne den mhéid atá ann sa roinn leabharlanna den phlean corparáideach. Déanann an plean seo na dualgais faoi alt 78 den Acht a shásamh freisin. Deir an t-alt seo "go n-ullmhóidh agus go n-uchtóidh údarás leabharlanna, ó am go chéile, clár chun críocha fheidhmiú agus fhorbairt a sheirbhís leabharlanna."

Agus iad ag ullmhú an phlean, thug an Chomhairle cuireadh don phobal - bíodh gur daoine a úsáideann an leabharlann nó nach ea - a gcuid tuairimí faoin tseirbhís a nochtadh agus moltaí a dhéanamh maidir le conas a d'fhéadfaí an tseirbhís a fheabhsú. Fuarthas timpeall 200 aighneacht i bhFómhar na bliana 2004. Tá na haighneachtaí seo, chomh maith le moltaí a dhein foireann na leabharlainne - dream a ghlac páirt iomlán sa phróiseas comhairliúcháin agus ullmhúcháin - mar bhunchloch den phlean.

Is éard atá sa phlean straitéiseach ná:

- plé ar an tseirbhís leabharlainne faoi mar atá sí faoi láthair agus ar a comhthéacs sóisialta agus eacnamaíochta sa chathair agus sa réigiún;
- scrúdú géar ar láidreachtaí agus laigí na seirbhíse leabharlainne, agus ar na deiseanna is na bagairtí seachtracha a chaithfidh sí aghaidh a thabhairt orthu;
- ráiteas ar chuspóir nó aidhm na seirbhíse leabharlainne san aonú aois fíchead;
- plean gníomhaíochta ag tabhairt le fios an méid atá i gceist ag an gComhairle a dhéanamh sa tréimhse 2005-2009 chun seirbhísí agus acmhainní na leabharlainne a fhorbairt, foirgnimh agus teicneolaíocht eolais agus cumarsáide a fhorbairt, rochtain agus cuimsitheacht shóisialta a fheabhsú, acmhainní daonna a fhorbairt, agus forbairtí ábhartha eile a chur i gcrích.

Cuirfeadh an plean seo i bhfeidhm sa chomhthéacs atá leagtha síos ag 'Branching Out', polasaí de chuid an rialtais

- in the 21<sup>st</sup> century;
- an action plan detailing what the Council intends to do in the period 2005-2009 to develop the library's resources and services, develop buildings and information & communications technologies, improve access and social inclusion, develop the human resource, and carry out other related developments.

This plan will be implemented in the context set by 'Branching Out', the government's policy for the library service geared to the needs of the 21<sup>st</sup> century, and 'National Network: Local Service', the public library standards prepared by the Library Association of Ireland. While the Council provides the revenue funding for the day-to-day operation of the library, central government, through the Department of the Environment, Heritage & Local Government, and An Chomhairle Leabharlanna, provides capital and project funding for new buildings, for the development of information and communications technologies, and for innovative projects.

The Council is committed to providing resources to improve the delivery of the library service, and will make full use of funding opportunities at national and local levels to ensure that the actions set out in this plan will be realised.

## 1.2 Cork City in the 21<sup>st</sup> century

Cork is located on the south coast of Ireland at the head of a large natural harbour. As a city in the European Union it has access to an internal market of over 450 million people. The current population of the city and surrounding area is 257,000 and this is projected to increase to 320,000 by 2020. Employment is projected to be 160,000 by 2020, an increase of 25% over the period. Cork is European Capital of Culture in 2005. (<http://www.cork2005.ie>)

Cork is a designated gateway city under the National Spatial Strategy, 2002-2020, which means that it is a national strategic growth centre with the critical mass needed to sustain strong levels of jobs growth (<http://www.irishspatialstrategy.com/NSSDownloads.shtml>). This designation will be implemented by a strong national policy response in the areas of greater accessibility (road, rail, air, telecommunications and energy), more opportunities for people to benefit from these opportunities through enhanced access to services, and a high quality environment. The outcomes will be economic success, social cohesion and sustainable development.

As the second largest city in the Republic of Ireland, Cork has benefited from some national governmental actions, some in place for over 20 years, that have contributed to growth in the Irish economy. These include stable public finances, continued significant investment in education, wage moderation through social partnership, targeting

## 1.2 Cathair Chorcaí sa 21ú aois

Tá Corcaigh suite ar chósta theas na hÉireann ag ceann cuain mhóir nádúrtha. Mar chathair san Aontas Eorpach, tá teacht aici ar mhargadh de níos mó ná 450 milliún duine. Is é 257,000 duine daonra na cathrach agus an limistéir máguaird i láthair na huairé agus meastar go méadóidh an figiúr seo go 320,000 duine faoin mbliain 2020. Táthar á thuar go mbeidh 160,000 duine fostaithe ann faoin mbliain chéanna – méadú de 25% idir seo agus sin.

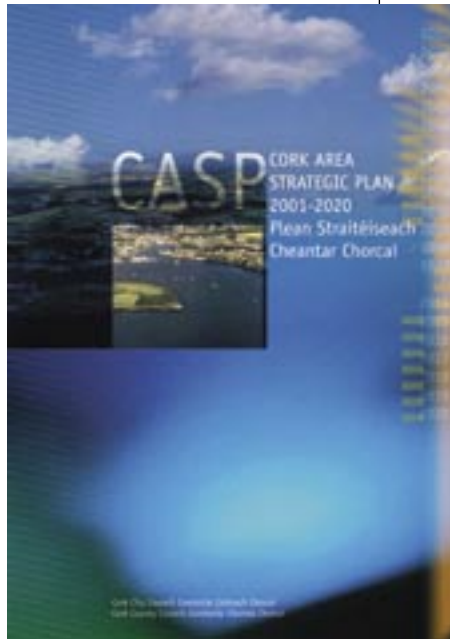
Tá Corcaigh ceaptha mar chathair idirghabhála faoin Straitéis Náisiúnta Spásúlachta, 2002-2020, rud a chiallaíonn gur ionad fáis straitéiseach náisiúnta é, leis an oiread daonra is gá chun fás leanúnach i bpostanna a chinntiú (<http://www.irishspatialstrategy.com/NSSDownloads.shtml>). Cuirfear an beartúchán seo i bhfeidhm trí pholasaí dian náisiúnta a bheith ann i leith rochtain níos forleithne (bóithre, iarnród, eitleáin/aer, teileachumarsáid agus fuinneamh), tuilleadh deiseanna nó tuilleadh daoine a bhainfidh tairbhe as na deiseanna seo trí rochtain níos fearr ar sheirbhísí, agus ar thimpeallacht d'ardchaighdeán. Beidh rathúlacht eacnamaíochta, comhtháthú sóisialta agus forbairt inbhuanaithe mar thoradh air seo.

Mar an dara cathair is mó i bPoblacht na hÉireann, tá leas bainte ag Corcaigh as gníomhaíochtaí náisiúnta de chuid an Rialtais, cuid acu atá i bhfeidhm le fiche bliain anuas, a chuir go mór le fás an gheilleagair in Éirinn. Ar na gníomhaíochta sin, áirítear airgeadas poiblí seasta, infheistíocht leanúnach san oideachas, measarthacht tuarastal trí chomhpháirtíocht shóisialta, roghnú tionscadal agus earnálacha margaidh thar lear, ballraíocht san Aontas Airgeadaíochta, agus méadú ollmhór ar lucht oibre trí fhás an daonra agus trí níos mó rannpháirtíochta.



of selected overseas industries and market sectors, membership of the European Monetary Union, and rapid expansion of the labour force through population growth and increased participation.

At the local level, the main strategy document covering Metro Cork (the city and surrounding region) is the *Cork Area Strategic Plan (CASP)* which was prepared by the Cork City Council and Cork County Council in 2002 (<http://www.corkcity.ie/corkstrategicplan/index.htm>) and sets out a development path to 2020. CASP deals mainly with the land use and infrastructure needs of the Cork Area to ensure continued social economic and cultural development. CASP has identified major development opportunities in the city's Docklands, and along a major growth corridor between Blarney and Middleton. The existing rail line will be the spine of this corridor which meets the Docklands area around Kent Station, the rail terminus for the city. CASP will also be implemented through the development plans of both Cork City Council and Cork County Council ([www.corkcity.ie/development/index.html](http://www.corkcity.ie/development/index.html)) and ([www.corkcoco.ie](http://www.corkcoco.ie)).



In order to co-ordinate the activities of state agencies locally, 34 development boards were established by government in 2000. These boards bring together the stakeholders in their respective areas – local government, state agencies, business and employers, voluntary, and community. Metro Cork is covered by two such development boards – the Cork City Development Board and the Cork County Development Board. Whereas CASP and the development plans of the city and county deal mostly with land use and infrastructure issues, the development boards must prepare integrated strategies for economic, social and cultural development. The Cork City Development Board's strategy is called *'Imagine Our Future'* (<http://www.corkcity.ie/ccdb/strategy.htm>) and the County strategy is at ([http://www.cdbcorkco.ie/integrated\\_strategy/](http://www.cdbcorkco.ie/integrated_strategy/)).

### Education in Cork

In the greater Cork area there are more than 370 primary schools including eleven special schools. These schools cater for a total enrolment of 52,456 pupils. There are

Ar bhonn áitiúil, is é Plean Straitéiseach Réigiúin Chorcaí an phríomhcháipéis straitéise a chlúdaíonn Metro Chorcaí (an chathair agus a bhfuil timpeall uirthi); cáipéis a d'ullmhaigh Comhairle Cathrach Chorcaí agus Comhairle Contae Chorcaí in 2002 (<http://www.corkcity.ie/corkstrategicplan/index.html>) agus a leagann amach cosán forbartha go dtí an bhliain 2020. Cuirfear CASP i bhfeidhm trí phleananna forbartha Chomhairle Cathrach Chorcaí agus Chomhairle Contae Chorcaí ([www.corkcity.ie/development/index.html](http://www.corkcity.ie/development/index.html)) and ([www.corkcoco.ie](http://www.corkcoco.ie)).

Chun gníomhaíochtaí na n-áisíneachtaí a chomhordnú ar bhonn áitiúil, bunaíodh 34 bord forbartha ag an rialtas sa bhliain 2000. Tugann na boird seo na páirtithe leasmhara le chéile i ngach réimse ábhartha – rialtas áitiúil, áisíneachtaí stáit, gnó agus fostaithe, deonach agus pobal. Tá Metro Chorcaí clúdaithe ag dhá bhord forbartha dá chineál – Bord Forbartha Chathair Chorcaí agus Bord Forbartha Chontae Chorcaí. Áit a bpléann CASP agus pleananna forbartha na cathrach agus an chontae le ceisteanna úsáide talún agus bonneagair, ní mór do na boird forbartha straitéisí comhtháite a ullmhú le haghaidh forbairt eacnamaíoch, shóisialta agus chultúrtha.

### An tOideachas i gCorcaigh

Tá níos mó ná 370 bunscoil i gcathair Chorcaí agus ina timpeall, lena n-áirítear 11 cinn de shainscoileanna. Tógann na scoileanna seo níos mó ná 52,456 dalta isteach ar an iomlán. Tá 91 meánscoil sa réigiún ag freastal ar 44,653 dalta. Tá níos mó ná 7,500 duine ag fágáil meánscoileanna i gcathair agus i gcontae Chorcaí gach bliain. Tá 4,000 díobh sin ar fáil le dul ag obair láithreach. Seasann Corcaigh amach mar chontae ina bhfuil oideachas agus oiliúint le fáil go forleathan ann. Is i gcathair Chorcaí atá ceann de na hollscoileanna is fearr sa tír, ceann de phríomhinstiúidí teicneolaíochta na tíre chomh maith le méid áirithe coláistí eile lonnaithe inti. Níl aon amhras ach go bhfuil an chathair oiriúnach do



91 second level schools in the area catering for 44,653 students. The total number leaving secondary schools in Cork city and county is in excess of 7,500 each year with more than 4,000 immediately available for work.

Cork is a significant centre for third level education and training in Ireland, with one of the country's leading universities and one of the country's principal institutes of technology located in the city, in addition to a number of other colleges. The city currently caters for a student population of ca 30,000, attending the various 3<sup>rd</sup> level institutes and training centres, studying both full-time and part-time courses.

### **Cork's cultural life**

Cork is a city with a varied and vibrant artistic community, and a fascinating cultural heritage. The activity of Cork's artists, musicians, writers, poets and players is evident on our streets, in our galleries and on our stages. Cork City Council is a leading player in the cultural life of the city, funding libraries, museum, theatres, art centres and a range of arts activities from opera to street arts.

The main cultural venues in the city include the Crawford Municipal Gallery of Art and the Opera House, both in Emmet Place, the Central Library on Grand Parade, the Public Museum in Fitzgerald Park, the Lewis Glucksman Gallery at UCC, the Everyman Place in MacCurtain Street, as well as venues such as Triskel Arts Centre, Tigh Filí, Kino Cinema and others.

Cork is known as a festival city; the International Choral Festival in May, the Midsummer Festival in June, the Beamish Folk Festival in September, the International Film Festival and the Guinness Jazz Festival, both in October, being just the best known annual festivals in the city's calendar.

### **Cork's economy**

The principal employment sectors in the Cork Area are pharmaceuticals / healthcare, information and communications technologies, and internationally traded services (software, shared services and e-commerce).

72,159 people work in Cork city, representing 61% of the employment in the Cork area. Professional services (29%) is the largest sector and this includes people working in the health and education sectors as well as legal, technical and accountancy services. The next largest sector is retail (17%) which reflects the City's role as the major retail centre for the south west region. The third largest employment sector is manufacturing/repairs (14%). This figure is augmented by the large companies which are located outside of the city boundaries. Personal services (10%) is the 4<sup>th</sup> largest sector and again reflects Cork's role as a service centre for the region as does the 9% figure for public administration and the 7% figure for business and finance.

### **Saol Cultúrtha Chorcaí**

Is cathair í Corcaigh ina bhfuil pobal ealaíona atá ilchineálach agus beo bríomhar. Tá gníomhaíochtaí ealaíontóirí, ceoltóirí, scríbhneoirí, filí agus fonnadóirí Chorcaí le feiceáil ar ár gcuid sráideanna, inár gcuid áiléirí agus ar ár gcuid stáitsí. Is ceannródaí í Comhairle Cathrach Chorcaí i saol cultúrtha na cathrach, ag maoiniú leabharlanna, iarsmalanna, amharclanna, ionad ealaíne agus réimse gníomhaíochtaí ealaíona ó cheoldrámaí go healaíon sráide.

Ar na hionaid chultúrtha is mó sa chathair, áirítear Gailearaí Cathrach Crawford na hEalaíona agus Cork Opera House, atá i bPlás Emmet, an Lárleabharlann ar Shráid an Chapail Bhuí, an Iarsmalann Phoiblí i bPáirc Mhic Ghearaill, Gailearaí Lewis Glucksman i gColáiste na hOllscoile, Pálás an Everyman ar Shráid Mhic Churtáin, chomh maith le hionaid ar nós Ionad Ealaíon Triskel, Tigh Filí, Pictiúrlann Kino agus eile.

Tá cáil ar Chorcaigh mar chathair d'fhéiltí; Féile Idirnáisiúnta na gCór i mí na Bealtaine, Féile Láir an tSamhraidh i mí an Mheitheamh, Féil Cheoil Traidisiúnta Beamish i mí Mheán Fómhair, An Fhéile Idirnáisiúnta Scannán agus Féile Snagcheoil Guinness, dhá fhéile a bhíonn ar siúl i mí Dheireadh Fómhair. Seo hiad na féiltí is mó clú agus cáil i bhféilire na cathrach.

### **Geilleagar Chorcaí**

Is iad na príomhearnálacha fostaíochta i gCorcaigh ná cógaisíochtaí, cúram sláinte, teicneolaíocht eolais agus cumarsáide, agus seirbhísí a thrádáiltear go hidirnáisiúnta (m.sh., bogearraí, seirbhísí roinnte agus ríomhthráchtáil).

Tá 72,159 duine ag obair i gcathair Chorcaí. Tá an figiúr seo ionadaíoch de 61% d'fhostaíocht réigiún Chorcaí. Is iad na seirbhísí gairmiúla (29%) an earnáil is mó agus clúdaíonn sí daoine atá ag obair sna hearnálacha sláinte agus oideachais chomh maith le seirbhísí dlíthiúla, teicniúla agus cuntasáíochta. Is í an chéad earnáil eile is mó ná miondíol (17%), rud a thaispeánann ról na cathrach mar mhóronad miondíola an iar-dheiscirt. An tríú hearnáil fostaíochta is mó is ea déantúsaíocht/deisiúcháin (14%). Cuireann na comhlachtaí móra atá lonnaithe taobh amuigh de theorannacha na cathrach leis an bhfigiúr (14%) seo. Seirbhísí pearsanta an ceathrú hearnáil is mó (10%) agus léiríonn an figiúr seo ról Chorcaí mar ionad seirbhíse don réigiún, faoi mar dhéanann na figiúirí 9% le haghaidh riarachán poiblí agus 7% le haghaidh gnó agus airgeadas.

### 1.3 Taking Stock: Cork City Library 1892-2004

Cork has long had significant collections of books for both learning and pleasure, from the time of the monastic community in Gillabbeey, through to the flowering of the various institutions founded by the great and good in the early 19<sup>th</sup> century, for example the Cork Literary and Scientific Society, the Royal Cork Institute, and the Cork Cuvierian Society. It was not until the last decade of the 19<sup>th</sup> century, however, that the public library service began in the city. The Corporation had acted quickly to ensure that Cork was the first of the Irish cities to adopt the Public Libraries (Ireland) Act of 1855, but waited until 1892 to establish the library. Following the election of a library committee of no fewer than 37 members, and the appointment of the first City Librarian, James Wilkinson, a public reading room opened in what is now the Crawford Municipal Gallery in December of that year.

In 1905, thanks to a grant from the renowned benefactor of libraries, Dunfermline-born Andrew Carnegie, a purpose built library was opened on Anglesea Street just beside the City Hall. This fine building lasted for only 15 years, however, as it and its contents were destroyed along with the adjacent City Hall and much of the city centre by Crown Forces who retaliated to continuing IRA guerrilla activity. The burning of the Carnegie Library left the city without a public library service until 1924 when a temporary premises was found in Tuckey Street. The Library was relocated 6 years later to a site between Tuckey Street and Kift's Lane that had previously housed a warehouse. A new building giving access to this space was constructed with a façade in the Hiberno-Romanesque style at no. 57 Grand Parade, and this remains.

For many years this was the only public library service point in the city, excepting the County Library at its Courthouse and Mardyke premises, until the opening of the library at St Mary's Road opposite the North Cathedral in 1972. This was soon augmented by another suburban library near Tory Top Park to serve the southside. In quick succession there followed the establishment of the Mobile Library service, the opening of Douglas Library in a shopping centre in that suburb (jointly funded by the City and County Councils) and the major extension of the Central Library at Grand Parade. These developments constitute a permanent testimony to the vision and energy of Sean Bohan who was City Librarian from the mid-1960s to the mid-1980s, a man widely acknowledged as one of the leading public librarians of his generation.

The creation of the network of local libraries is perhaps the most important development in the history of the service. For many decades people from all over the city, most notably children, had to come to the Grand Parade

### 1.3 Ag Féachaint Siar: Leabharlann Chathair Chorcaí 1892-2004

Tá bailiúcháin suntasacha leabhar ag Corcaigh le fada an lá ; idir leabhair foghlama agus leabhair phléisiúir. Tá na leabhair seo á mbailiú ón am ar chuir na manaigh fúthu sa Mhainistir i gCorcaigh agus ar aghaidh tríd obair na n-institiúidí éagsúla a bunaíodh ag tús an naoú haois déag, m.sh., Cork Literary and Scientific Society, Royal Cork Institute agus Cork Cuvierian Society. Ní go dtí deireadh 19ú aois áfach a cuireadh tús leis an tseirbhís phoiblí leabharlainne sa chathair. Thapaigh an Bardas an deis le cinntiú gurb é Corcaigh an chéad chathair Éireannach a d'fheidhmeodh Acht na Leabharlanna Poiblí (Éire) 1855, ach d'fhan go dtí 1892 chun an leabharlann a bhunú. I ndiaidh do choiste leabharlainne, le líon ball níos airde ná 37, a bheith tofa agus tar éis dóibh an chéad leabharlannaí cathrach, James Wilkinson a cheapadh, osclaíodh seomra poiblí léitheoireachta san áit ina bhfuil Gailearaí Crawford na Cathrach anois, i Nollaig na bliana sin.

Sa bhliain 1905, osclaíodh foirgneamh a tógadh d'aon ghnó mar leabharlann ar Shráid Anglesea díreach in aice le Halla na Cathrach, a bhuíochas sin do dheontas ón bpátrún leabharlanna cáiliúil, Andrew Carnegie, arbh as Dunfermline na hAlban dó ó dhúchas. Ní raibh an foirgneamh breá seo ann ach ar feadh 15 bliain áfach, mar gur scrios Fórsaí na Breataine é agus an t-ábhar a bhí istigh ann, maraon le Halla na Cathrach mórán de lár na cathrach, agus iad ag lorg díoltais ar ghníomhaíochtaí leanúnacha an IRA ag an am. D'fhág loisceadh Leabharlann Carnegie an chathair gan seirbhís phoiblí leabharlainne go dtí 1924, nuair a fuarthas áitreabh sealadach ar Shráid Tuckey. Aistríodh an leabharlann sé bliana níos déanaí go suíomh nua idir Sráid Tuckey agus Lána Kift, áit a mbíodh trádstóras roimhe sin. Tógadh foirgneamh nua san áit seo bunaithe ar an stíl Hiberno-Romanesque ar Shráid an Chapail Bhuí [uimhir 57] agus tá an foirgneamh seo fós ann.

Ar feadh na mblianta, ba é seo an t-aon áit sa chathair go raibh seirbhís phoiblí leabharlainne ann, seachas Leabharlann Chontae i dTeach na Cúirte agus áitreabh Mardyke, go dtí gur osclaíodh leabharlann nua ar Bhóthar Naomh Mhuire os comhair na hArdeaglaise Thuaidh sa bhliain 1972. Tógadh leabharlann eile gar do Pháirc na mBuaircíní go gairid ina dhiaidh sin le freastal ar dheisceart na cathrach. Laistigh d'achar gairid, bunaíodh an tseirbhís leabharlanna taistil, osclaíodh Leabharlann na Dúglaise san ionad siopadóireachta atá ann (faigheann an leabharlann seo comh-mhaoiniú ó na Comhairlí Cathrach agus Contae), agus deineadh fairsingiú agus atógáil ar an Lárleabharlann ar Shráid an Chapail Bhuí. Údar aitheantais agus molta iad na forbairtí seo d'fhís agus d'fhuinneamh Sheáin Uí Bhuacháin, a bhí ina Leabharlannaí Cathrach ó lár na seascaidí go lár na n-ochtóidí. Fear é seo go nglactar leis go forleathan ina thaobh gurbh é ceann de na

for their reading material, and long queues were a feature of those years, making the borrowing of books less than pleasant for public and staff alike. From the time of the opening of Douglas Library the total number of issues of books from the suburban libraries has consistently exceeded that of the Central Library, illustrating how important the network of local libraries is to the people of the city. The Central Library on the Grand Parade is the most important such facility outside Dublin, and remains the main focus of specialist services such as reference & information, local studies and music.

Since the mid-1980s the network of local libraries has been extended with two new libraries serving the northside: Mayfield and Hollyhill. The main feature of development in the last two decades, however, has been the revolution in library provision through the use of information & communications technology. The term first used to describe the use of computers in libraries - automation - betrays how libraries expected to make use of them: they would, it was thought, only be used to automate existing practices and carry out the numbers crunching. This was largely true in the early years.

Since the late 1990s the emphasis has changed completely, and the term now in use - information and communications technologies - indicates how personal computers are now primarily a tool to enable the public, and indeed the library staff, to link with the world wide web, to access online databases of all kinds, and to allow people with no access to PCs at home or at work to communicate by e-mail with friends and colleagues all over the world. In addition the Horizon system - which staff use to catalogue, issue and return books and other stock - offers more functionality and more options for management information than the previous system.

The latest use of information & communications technologies, like the earlier phase part-funded by central government, has been in what is called digitisation: the scanning of maps, photographs, prints and other images to an online database so that they can be viewed and downloaded via the web. The digitisation project in the City Library is concentrating on material of Cork interest, but when the images are available on the web access will be without limits.

Tá an Lárleabharlann ar Shráid an Chapail Bhuí ar an áis is tábhachtaí dá leithéid taobh amuigh de Bhaile Átha Cliath, agus is í is mó a sholáthraíonn sainseirbhísí don phobal fós; seirbhísí mar tagairt agus eolas, staidéar áitiúil agus ceol.

Ó lár na n-ochtóidí ar aghaidh tá curtha leis an líonra áitiúil leabharlanna, mar a bhfuil dhá leabharlann nua anois ag freastal ar an taobh thuaidh den chathair: Gort Álainn agus Cnoc an Chuilinn. Is í an phríomhghné den fhorbairt le 20 bliain anuas ná an réabhlóid atá tarlaithe maidir le soláthar leabharlanna de bharr úsáid na teicneolaíochta eolais agus cumarsáide. Ní thugann an téarma a úsáidtear chun cur síos a dhéanamh ar úsáid ríomhairí i leabharlanna - uathobriú - pictiúr cruinn den mhéid go rabhthas ag súil leis ó leabharlanna maidir lena n-úsáid: samhlaíodh ná

beadh d'úsáid sna ríomhairí ach slí chun cómhaireamh uimhreacha a éascú. Bhí sé seo fíor cuid mhór sna blianta tosaigh.

Ach ó dheireadh na nóchaidí i leith, tá an bhéim athraithe ar fad agus tugann an téarma atá in úsáid anois - teicneolaíocht eolais agus cumarsáide - le tuiscint gur uirlis í an ríomhaire pearsanta a cheadaíonn don phobal, agus go deimhin don fhoireann leabharlainne, nascadh leis an ngréasán domhanda, rochtain a fháil ar bhunachar sonraí de gach cineál, agus ligean do dhaoine nach bhfuil ríomhaire pearsanta acu sa bhaile nó san ionad oibre teagmháil a dhéanamh le cairde agus comhghleacaithe dá gcuid ar fud an domhain trí ríomhphost. Chomh maith leis sin, tairgeann córas

In the last few years the library service has continued to expand its services. Funding approval has been received from central government for a new building to replace the Tory Top Library, and this is expected to be opened in 2005, and approval has also been granted for a major library serving Bishopstown and the western suburbs.

In summary, the City Library has established itself as an integral feature of the city's cultural landscape, so woven into the fabric of the lives of countless Corkonians over the years as to be almost invisible. The Library's profile in the city does not fully reflect how important it is to people who use it as a resource for learning, to feed their love of music, to nurture their love of place, and to children and their parents as their primary gateway to the world of knowledge and the joy of reading.

Looking ahead, the unique specialist services – local studies, reference, music, and children's resources – need to be refocused and renewed, and the network of local libraries needs to be completed and reinvigorated.

Cosúil leis an tréimhse níos luaithe, a bhí páirtmhaoinithe ag an rialtas láir, is í an úsáid is déanaí de theicneolaíocht eolais agus cumarsáide ná i réimse ar a dtugtar digitíú: ciallaíonn sé seo go ndéantar léirscáileanna, grianghraif, príontáilithe agus íomhánna eile a scanáil isteach go bunachar sonraí ar líne chun gur féidir iad a fheiceáil agus a íoslódáil ón ngréasán. Tá an tionscnamh digitithe atá ar bun i Leabharlann na Cathrach ag díriú ar ábhar a bhaineann le Corcaigh, ach nuair a bheidh na híomhánna ar fáil ar an ngréasán ní bheidh teorainn ar bith leis an rochtain.

Le blianta beaga anuas tá an tseirbhís leabharlanna ag cur lena cuid seirbhísí go leanúnach. Ceadaíodh maoiniú ón rialtas láir d'fhoirgneamh nua a thiocfaidh in áit Leabharlann Bhóthar na mBuaircíní. Táthar ag súil go mbeidh sé seo oscailte sa bhliain 2005 agus tugadh cead le haghaidh leabharlainne móire a fhreastalóidh ar Bhaile an Easpaig agus ar na bruachbhailte thiar.

Mar achoimre, tá áit lárnach bainte amach ag an leabharlann i gcultúr na cathrach. Tá sí chomh fite fúite i saol muintir na cathrach gur ar éigin go dtugtar faoi deara í. Ní léiríonn próifíl na Leabharlainne cé chomh tábhachtach agus atá sí don phobal mar acmhainn foghlamtha, mar áis chun meas ar cheol a fhorbairt agus grá don áit dúchais a chothú. Is oscailt í ar domhan an eolais agus taitneamh na léitheoireachta do pháistí agus a dtuismitheoirí. Ag féachaint ar aghaidh, ní mór do na sainseirbhísí speisialta – staidéar áitiúil, tagairt, ceol agus acmhainní do pháistí – ní mór iad a athdhíriú agus a athnuachan, agus ní mór críoch a chur leis an líonra áitiúil leabharlanna agus é a athneartú.

## 1.4 The Future of Library Services: assessing the environment

### 1.4.1 External environment: Opportunities and Threats

Over the period of this plan the library service faces both opportunities and threats in society at large and in the external environment generally.

#### Opportunities

There is a greater emphasis on learning in society, and the population of the city and of Ireland generally is becoming more educated.

In the formal education system and in schools

- there are changes in curricula at all levels;
- schools are more interested in building stronger links with the library;
- parents see libraries as a safe place for children after school, and as a place which can help realise their ambitions for their children.

In the area of lifelong learning

- interest in and take-up of distance education continues to grow;
- there is a greater demand for adult education classes of all types.

Libraries are well placed to meet the thirst for knowledge in society. They can build on existing links with students and researchers, with their unique resources of books, newspapers, journals, archives etc.

There is a greater emphasis on cultural expression in society.

More people want to use their leisure time purposefully; this offers the chance to respond to existing and future demands

- children's cultural activities are already well established;
- libraries have a well-developed programme of cultural activities for adults;
- comprehensive culture and the imagination stock: literature, music, the arts;
- European Capital of Culture in 2005 opens the door to a much enhanced cultural role for libraries, and can instil pride and cultural awareness throughout the network of libraries;
- Libraries are seen as an important cultural resource.

## 1.4 Todhchaí na Seirbhísí Leabharlanna: ag meas na timpeallachta

### 1.4.1 An Timpeallacht Sheachtrach: Deiseanna agus Bagairtí

I rith tréimhse an phlean seo, tugann an leabharlann aghaidh ar dheiseanna agus bhagairtí sa sochaí agus sa timpeallacht sheachtrach go ginearálta.

#### Deiseanna

Tá béim níos mó ar fhoghlaim sa sochaí agus tá níos mó oideachais ar dhaonra na cathrach agus na hÉireann i gcoitinne.

Sa chóras oideachais foirmiúil agus i scoileanna

- tá athruithe i gcuraclaim ag gach leibhéal;
- tá suim níos mó ag scoileanna naisc níos láidre a chothú leis an leabharlann;
- féachann tuismitheoirí ar leabharlanna mar áit shábháilte dá bpáistí le dul i ndiaidh na scoile agus mar áit gur féidir leo a mianta dá bpáistí a chomhlíonadh.

I réimse na foghlamtha leanúnaigh

- tá fás ag teacht ar an méid suime atá ag daoine sa chianoideachas agus tá níos mó daoine ag glacadh páirte ann;
- tá níos mó éilimh ar ranganna oideachais aosaigh de gach sórt.

Tá leabharlanna in ann an tóir atá ar eolas a shásamh. Is féidir leo na naisc atá acu le mic léinn agus taighdeoirí, agus a gcuid acmhainní leabhar, nuachtán, irisí, cartlanna, srl. a fhorbairt.

Tá níos mó béime ar chur in iúl cultúrtha.

Teastaíonn ó dhaoine an úsáid is fiúntaí agus is féidir a bhaint as a gcuid ama saor. Cruthaíonn sé seo deis freastal ar éilimh seirbhíse atá ann faoi láthair agus a bheidh ann amach anseo.

- gníomhaíochtaí cultúrtha do pháistí bunaithe le fada an lá;
- clár gníomhaíochtaí cultúrtha do dhaoine fásta forbartha go maith ag leabharlanna;
- cultúr cuimsitheach agus stoc na samhlaíochta: an litríocht, ceol agus na healaíona;
- cruthaíonn Príomhchathair Chultúrtha na hEorpa 2005 deis ról cultúrtha níos fearr a bheith ag leabharlanna. Is féidir leis an mbronnadh seo bród agus comhfhiosacht chultúrtha a mhúscaill trí líonra na leabharlanna;
- féachtar ar leabharlanna mar acmhainn cultúrtha tábhachtach.

There is a greater emphasis on social inclusion; libraries can respond by

- building partnerships with community groups;
- building on the good public perception of the library by users (e.g. PLUS Survey);
- building on the good relationship with schools, community groups, and education providers;
- expanding the existing customer base: 20%+ of the public are already members and many more use the service;
- building on the existing network of service points.

The media are generally favourable to libraries; we can

- make use of media opportunities in a more strategic way;
- improve and fine-tune our marketing e.g. distribute attractive brochures in targeted areas;
- further develop the programme of annual events: Children's Book Festival, Bealtaine, Heritage Week, World Book Day, Family Day, etc.;
- use the internet to advertise and improve the libraries web page;
- seek outside funding/sponsorship for particular activities.

Libraries can make use of national and governmental initiatives, including

- evolution of local government with more emphasis on cultural policy and planning, through appointment of arts officers, archivists, heritage officers, establishment of Social Inclusion Office, City Development Board etc.;
- implementation of the *Branching Out* report in all its aspects;
- supportive national library organisations: LAI, An Chomhairle Leabharlanna.

Population changes will mean

- a new customer base including people born outside Ireland;
- a healthier older population, many of them already library users.

## Threats

We must address potential commercial & competitive pressures, such as

- libraries face encroachment/competition from other leisure opportunities, including TV, video, internet;
- we offer a poor image to non-users who expect levels of service found in the commercial & private sector services areas;
- increasing prosperity encourages many people to buy their own books, with changes in the book

- an t-idirlíon a úsáid i gcomhair fógraíochta agus chun láithreán gréasáin na leabharlanna a fheabhsú;
- maoiniú/urraíocht sheachtrach a lorg le haghaidh gníomhaíochtaí áirithe.

Is féidir le leabharlanna úsáid a bhaint as tionscnaimh rialtais agus náisiúnta, lena n-áirítear

- web developments may impact negatively on publishing over the next 5-10 years.

#### Negative societal changes present potential dangers

- the value of books and reading is unappreciated in many homes, where parents, not least single parents, are under serious time constraints,
- children have less freedom with parents working longer hours;
- developments in ICT may have serious budgetary implications: e.g. internet access costs, PC obsolescence.

#### Political reorientation & institutional changes are already having an impact

- charges put many potential users off, especially when they are aware of cheaper or free services by other providers e.g. Cork County Library does not charge for internet.
- libraries remain a low priority in local government structure;
- decision makers perceive the library's role as an optional leisure service;
- decision makers are not generally well informed about the role of the library in cultural life and learning;
- there is apathy towards library service among many local and national politicians;
- local government funding is again under pressure, leading to cuts in real terms;
- funding is already too low; the bookfund is below the target level recommended by central government.

#### Partnerships and co-operation are not sufficiently developed

- co-operation with other libraries in the Cork area needs to be much more effective;
- links with education bodies & community groups are not strong enough;
- partnerships with educational bodies to address changes in society are not sufficiently developed.

Other threats include

- library infrastructure is poor, especially our buildings;
- we face the potential loss of staff to other organisations and/or other sections of the public service with more promotional opportunities;
- we may see an increase in the incidence of abusive users in an increasingly less well-mannered society.

#### 1.4.2 Organisational issues: Strengths and Weaknesses

In terms of its own organisation the library service must strengthen areas in which it is already strong, and address its weaknesses.

##### Strengths

The Library offers a distinctive range and quality of services

- book & multimedia lending for children and adults;
- specialist services such as reference, music, local studies;
- a local and general information centre, with a no-charge genealogy service;
- internet access at low cost;
- a good and varied outreach programme, with cultural activities for adults and children, free of charge;
- constantly expanding collections: these provide an educational, community & cultural heritage resource supporting schools and the curriculum, and independent research and study;
- as a local government service it offers continuity with an established budget line.

The Library offers new and improving services, including

- significant advances in information & communications technologies (ICT);
- enhanced accessibility: 6-day opening, lunchtime opening, and evening opening in local libraries;
- the service is responsive to change: there is increasing diversity of library collections and services in response to the changing nature of the society we serve: e.g. libraries respond to the needs of refugees, community education, social inclusion, and a variety of community groups.

The library offers improving facilities, including

- strategic city-wide locations offering a presence in local communities;
- new buildings promising a more positive profile for the future e.g. Tory Top, Bishopstown, Blackrock-Mahon;

- a welcoming environment: a non-threatening, friendly, neutral space open to all;
- a social outlet for isolated individuals in society;
- venues for community educational initiatives and groups;
- an accessible cultural resource.

The human resource is one of the main strengths of the library service, with

- skilled, motivated, positive, versatile staff;
- a proven track record in meeting the public's needs.

### Weaknesses

The City Libraries' services & resources require major improvements

- libraries are perceived as being stuck in a traditional mode;
- services are underdeveloped due to overstretching and lack of clear focus;
- there is poor exploitation of stock, and a need for more regular stocktakes;
- there is a continuing failure to attract 15-25 year olds;
- the book supply system must improve to reduce delays in getting new titles to users;
- there is a need to reach out more to disadvantaged groups;
- there is an inadequate housebound service;
- there is no loop system for the hard of hearing;
- there is a need to make better provision for children with disabilities;
- the service to immigrants and asylum seekers is undeveloped in terms of service in first languages;
- there is often poor follow-through on projects.

The City Libraries' facilities do not meet the public's expectations

The poor physical condition of older buildings makes them unsuitable for the demands of a modern library service; problems include:

- Central Library:
  - » the building is far too small and suffers from poor fabric;
  - » the lack of public toilets is a matter of concern to the public;
  - » accessibility for people with disabilities is inadequate – parking, wheelchair access;

  - » there is a lack of meeting rooms for community groups and library clubs;
  - » there is poor signage internally and externally;
  - » the mobile library is c. 30 years old.

There are major human resource issues to be addressed, for example

- there are insufficient staff to exploit all services;
- there is a need to assess grading structure and numbers;
- the service suffers from lack of relief staff;
- major improvements are needed in staff training & education;
- safety & security of staff needs to be addressed;
- rigid thinking with regard to staff roles and tasks needs to be addressed;
- morale suffers from monotony of job at certain grades.

Promotion and marketing have never received sufficient resourcing

- the service suffers from lack of in-house promotion expertise;
- usage suffers due to poor public awareness of the range and depth of services and of the recently improved opening hours;
- there is a need for library informational material to be available in translation.

Opening hours, while recently improved, need to be reviewed

- the service suffers because of non-standardised opening hours;
- opening hours need to better reflect community needs;
- the issue of evening opening in the city centre needs to be addressed.

Charges are high in comparison to other library authorities

#### Other weaknesses include

- the absence of real regular in-depth service analysis, due to insufficient staff;
- a need to monitor user needs much more clearly;
- the service lacks focus because of failure to develop policies in key areas;
- a feeling of isolation in branches and in some departments of Central Library.

### 1.4.3 Key challenges

In summary the Council faces a number of key challenges in developing the library service; how the Council faces up to these will determine how well we achieve the objectives of this plan:

#### The Human Resource

- we need to provide adequate staffing levels;
- we need to improve staff conditions and provide promotional opportunities;
- we need to improve the motivation of staff;
- we need to address the effect of competing pressures on staff.

#### External Competition

- we are competing for leisure time with more commercial outlets: we must make the library service more attractive;
- we need to understand and address the impact of new developments, e.g. electronic books, web publishing, and the Copyright & Related Rights Act, 2000.

#### Lack of Resources

- we must address staffing deficits;
- we must improve investment in recurrent programmes;
- we must improve investment in capital projects;
- we must maximise the use of scarce resources; and find the resources to achieve what is possible;
- we must address infrastructural deficits.

### Image and Profile

- we must address people's previous negative experience of the service;
- We must address the lack of interest in and perceived lack of relevance of the library;
- we must raise the profile of the library in a positive way within and outside the Council.

### Providing a quality service

- we must provide a clear vision for the development of the service;
- we must build a service to a minimum professional standard;
- we must aim to achieve exceptional work on a consistent basis;
- we must make Cork City Libraries a national leader;
- we must provide regular external reviews and assessment, and continually check the relevance of each aspect of the service;
- we must reach an increasingly diverse population.

## 2. The Purpose of the Library Service

Cork City Council provides a library and information service to support learning and the independent quest for knowledge, and to meet the public's interest in books and reading, and the arts. By so doing, it enriches the lives of every member of society, and increases their social, cultural and economic opportunities.

Libraries are a quality of life service, a means of enrichment through both focused and relatively unfocused activity – reading in order to find out, and reading for its own sake. The library is thus a place of fulfilment and joy, for young and old.

### 2.1 Core Objectives

The Council will ensure that each Library will be:

#### A Resource for Children and Young People:

the library will be a gateway to the world of knowledge for children, it will actively help children to develop their literacy and information skills, and will act as a centre for culture for children and young people.

#### A Resource for Information and Learning:

the library will be a key focus of a true 'learning city' supporting adult learners and education generally; it will bridge information gaps and meet the citizen's right to know by providing accurate and up-to-date information, including information for business, economic and community development, and citizen action; the library will act as the collective memory of Cork by comprehensively collecting, making available, and promoting local studies material of all types.

#### A Resource for Culture and the Imagination:

the library will promote interest in literature, books and reading; it will meet the public's need for recorded & printed music materials and a range of other media; the library will support literature in Irish, and Gaelic culture generally; and will act as a focal point and welcoming space for reading and social and cultural activities.

To ensure that everyone in the city has access to these resources, the Council will provide a network of modern libraries, with the Central Library at its hub, which will:

- Be staffed with well-trained, welcoming, expert and accessible staff, in appropriate numbers and at appropriate levels;
- Be housed in purpose built or purpose designed, conveniently located, welcoming and fully

## 2. Cuspóir na Seirbhíse Leabharlanna

Cuireann Comhairle Cathrach Chorcaí seirbhís leabharlanna agus eolais ar fáil chun tacú le foghlaim agus le tóraíocht neamhspleách an eolais. - Be promoted and marketed to maximise its use by people in every community in the city and its environs.

## 2.2 A Quality Service

Cork City Council will provide a constantly improving library service, and will aim to achieve and demonstrate value for money, high standards of service, efficiency, courtesy and accountability.

The Council will:

- Develop a deeper understanding of the needs of individuals and communities for library services and cultural development, and put in place procedures to respond quickly to these needs;
- Develop a deeper understanding of the diverse and changing nature of society in the city, and ensure that services evolve to match diversity and change;
- Ensure that the resources of the library service are, in as far as practicable, available at times which suit the public;
- Develop the library service in Cork city to recognised international professional standards, and to make the library service in Cork a national and international leader by consistently meeting the highest standards of provision;
- Ensure that there are appropriate evaluation mechanisms in place, including surveys and complaints procedures, to assess the value and impact of the library service, and the degree to which it achieves its stated objectives.

- Tuiscint níos doimhne a fhorbairt ar riachtanais an duine aonair agus pobal le haghaidh seirbhísí leabharlanna agus forbairt chultúrtha, agus nósanna imeachta a chur i bhfeidhm le freastal ar na riachtanais seo go tapaidh;
- Tuiscint níos doimhne a fhorbairt ar chomhdhéanamh pobal na cathrach atá ag athrú de shíor, agus a chinntiú go bhforbrófar seirbhísí de réir mar is gá;

## 2.3 Libraries for All: Social Inclusion

Cork City Council will, through its library service, seek to make Cork a more just and inclusive society with increasing social cohesion and solidarity, and with cultural and informational programmes open to everyone.

Cork City Council recognises that social inclusion policies must provide for a wide range of goals, including equitable access to information and cultural activities. Social inclusion must cover more than the world of work, both because a healthy society should follow other priorities besides the work ethic, and because at any given time many people are outside the world of work.

The Council will:

- Ensure that the provision of library services shall evolve in a way designed to reduce social and geographical exclusion and inequality, and to enable more citizens to take an active part in society;
- Ensure that all its library buildings will be accessible to all members of the community;
- Ensure that its library service will secure access to all types of published information, irrespective of physical formats;
- Offer adult lifelong learning and training opportunities;
- Enable all citizens to have access to information & communications technologies;
- Ensure that the opportunities offered by the Information Society of increasing wealth and greater availability of information within society generally are available to everyone in the city, and counter the threat of a widening information gap which would result in growing social exclusion;
- Support cultural identity and cultural diversity in a rapidly changing city.

## 2.3 Leabharlanna do Chách: Cuimsitheacht Shóisialta

- go ndéanfaidh an tseirbhís leabharlanna rochtain a fháil ar gach cineál ábhar foilsithe, cuma cén fhormáid fhisiciúil atá orthu;
- deiseanna foghlamtha agus oiliúna saoil a thairiscint do dhaoine fásta;
- cur ar chumas gach saoránaigh teacht a bheith acu ar theicneolaíocht eolais agus cumarsáide.

### 3. Action Plan for the Library Service 2005-2009

#### 3.1 Introduction

Cork City Council believes that Cork City Libraries, like any service to the public, will benefit from a strategic approach to the development of its services and facilities, with the emphasis on the implementation of strategic actions. Thus this Action Plan looks ahead 10 to 20 years, but plans in detail for the next 5 years.

With this Action Plan, the Council intends to position Cork City Libraries as a key support for the learning city: a real and effective gateway to the world of knowledge for children and young people, a proactive and focused support for adult independent learning, and for persons undertaking distance education. In the first year of this plan, Cork's year as European Capital of Culture offers enormous opportunities for Libraries to position themselves as centres of literature and culture, and the Council intends that these opportunities will be grasped.

Cork City Council

- sees libraries primarily in terms of resources for the people of the city rather than as buildings or institutions.
- endorses the democratic and egalitarian assumptions and principles on which public libraries are based and believes that:
  - » the city requires the full use of all our human resources to be successful in the new century, economically, socially and culturally;
  - » all citizens have the right of equal access to knowledge, to creative expression, and to the recorded and material heritage, in order to develop their full capabilities and to direct their own lives;
  - » democratic government at both local and national levels needs an informed and educated electorate;
  - » all citizens must have easy access to information and communications technologies so that the people of Cork may fully embrace the opportunities offered by the Information Society.
- will provide materials and organize programmes in libraries which will not only enable the people of the city to know ourselves better, but to know about the world in all its variety and complexity.
- intends that its library service shall meet these requirements in a manner which is efficient and practical as well as democratic, by giving the whole of the population access to the whole

### 3. Plean Gnámh don tSeirbhís Leabharlainne 2005-2009

#### 3.1 Réamhrá

Creideann Comhairle Cathrach Chorcaí go mbainfidh Leabharlanna Chathair Chorcaí, ach an oiread le haon seirbhís don phobal, tairbhe as cur chuige straitéiseach maidir le forbairt a gcuid seirbhísí agus a gcuid saoráidí, le béim ar fheidhmiú gníomh straitéiseach. Sa chéad bhliain den phlean seo, cuireann an bhliain atá ag Corcaigh mar Phríomhchathair Chultúrtha na hEorpa deiseanna iontacha ar fáil do Leabharlanna iad féin a chur chun cinn mar ionaid litríochta agus cultúir, agus féachfaidh an Chomhairle chuige go mbainfear leas as na deiseanna sin.

- feiceann sí leabharlanna go príomha mar áiteanna chun acmhainní a chur ar fáil do mhuintir na cathrach seachas iad a fheiceáil mar fhoirgnimh nó mar institiúidí.

  - » go gcaithfidh rochtain éasca a bheith ag gach saoránach ar eolas agus ar theicneolaíochtaí cumarsáide ionas go mbeidh muintir Chorcaí in ann tairbhe agus leas iomlán a bhaint as na deiseanna a chuireann Sochaí an Eolais ar fáil dóibh.
- cuirfidh an Chomhairle ábhair ar fáil agus eagróidh sí cláir i leabharlanna agus ní hamháin go gcuirfidh siad ar chumas muintir na

The library service of 21<sup>st</sup>-century Cork will be delivered in three interwoven strands:

- 1) through the Central Library, with its specialist services and the largest collections of stock for children and adults;
- 2) through the network of local libraries serving all areas of the city with a range of services based on the actual needs of the local communities being served; and
- 3) through an e-Library facility offering a full virtual library service with online transactions – registration, renewals, requests – and access to digital collections provided directly or via web links.

This Action Plan is organised in four main sections: firstly, actions relating to the resources and activities which define a modern library service; secondly, actions relating to the buildings and the information & communications technologies to accommodate these resources and activities; thirdly, actions relating to the role of libraries in society; and finally, actions relating to the support services, human resources and funding needed for the effective delivery of the resources and activities.

## 3.2 A Resource for All

At the heart of the library service are its resources – books, CDs, DVDs and other materials, online resources, activities, and continuing programmes. It is vital that expenditure on resources should be focused on the actual needs of the people we serve, ensuring that we provide the right book or other material to the right person at the right time.

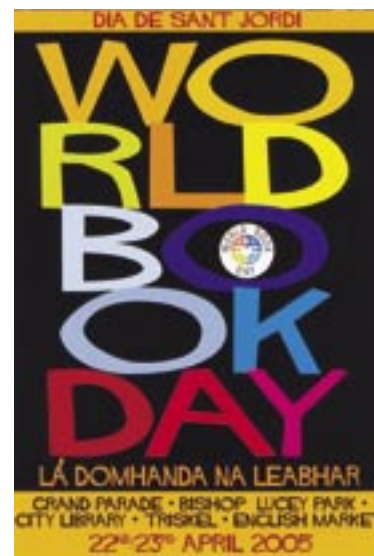

### 3.3. Library Infrastructure

#### 3.3.1 Developing Library Infrastructure: new library buildings

At the time of preparation of this plan the new library at Tory Top was nearing completion. This will be a major improvement on the previous facility.

The western suburbs of the city have been badly served over the years, with only a weekly mobile library service for an area of close on 30,000 people. The Council has finalised plans to develop a new library in Bishopstown, and tenders have been sought and received for this project. The Council's next priority, after Bishopstown, is a library to serve the Blackrock and Mahon communities.

The Central Library is no longer adequate in size or in facilities for a city of Cork's population and status, while some of the other service points need to be either replaced, or refurbished to a greater or lesser degree.

## 3.4 Libraries in Society

Libraries are a publicly funded intervention in the lives of individuals and communities. The Council recognises that making library services available is not of itself enough; coherent and sustained efforts are required to ensure that libraries are accessible in a real sense, and are used to their full potential by everyone in the city. ## 3.5 Other Actions

### 3.5.1 Support Services

Effective and efficient behind-the-scenes procedures are vital to the delivery of a quality service to the public. These procedures include the selection, purchasing, and distribution of stock, the administration of payments, and co-ordination with Personnel, Finance, Information Systems and other key Council functions.

### Key Result: More focused and effective support services

### 3.5.2 Human Resources

The quality of service we provide to the public is the cornerstone of the library service we seek. It is vital for the successful development of the service that we have well trained, welcoming and motivated staff in all service points; they are the face of the library. The knowledge and experience built up over the years by staff is an irreplaceable resource; Cork City Libraries are fortunate to have such a body of experienced and expert staff in key areas of the service. In the future it will be increasingly important to have real cross-fertilisation and co-ordination between staff in the three strands of service – the Central Library, the network of local libraries, and the online e-Library service.

The Council will bring forward proposals for a new staffing structure which will map out the organization which must be put in place in the library service. The Branching Out and National Network ~ Local Service documents assign new roles and new responsibilities to librarians at different levels of the service, and the Council recognises that library staff have already taken on these new roles and responsibilities.
